The Oklahoma Floodplain Managers Association is seeking abstracts for presentations to be given at its 2010 Annual Conference. Presentations should fit within the theme of this 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference, which will be “Basics and Beyond: Community Outreach and Higher Standards”.

This conference will provide special learning opportunities for individuals in a variety of fields associated with floodplain management, including education, insurance, planning, code enforcement, real estate, and planning. Abstracts relating floodplain management to these fields will receive enhanced consideration.

Industry professionals and service providers, including engineering, design, surveying and consulting firms, are encouraged to submit presentation abstracts that demonstrate ways in which their services or products can assist with outreach efforts or development and implementation of higher standards. Exhibitor and sponsorship opportunities are available to help showcase these services and products.

Abstracts should note intended length of presentation, as a variety of different opportunities exist throughout the conference.

All presenters must be registered attendees. Conference attendance provides continuing education credit for Certified Floodplain Managers and may be approved for continuing education credit in a variety of fields. Hardship scholarships may be available for presenters. Graduate and undergraduate students are encouraged to submit abstracts and will be eligible for reduced registration fees.
